If you have not already done so and you are driving your golf cart around town, please stop by the town hall and purchase your golf cart permit for 2025. Bring proof of insurance. The cost of the permit is \$10.00.

FIREWORKS We understand that most everyone loves a good fireworks show in the month of July but there are rules and regulations put in place by White County and the Town of Chalmers adheres to these rules. All fireworks shows are required by law to end by 11:00pm on weekdays and 12:00am on weekends with exceptions being made for Memorial Day, Fourth of July, and Labor Day, on these three days fireworks are to cease at 12:00am. Please respect your neighbors and adhere to the rules. Also please use caution when setting off fireworks, we all have a story of the time so and so got hurt setting them off.

BURN ORDINANCE The Town of Chalmers Burn Ordinance only allows recreational fires in contained firepits up to 3' by 3'. For more information, please visit the Clerk's Office at the town hall to pick up a

PARK NEWS The park board is excited to announce that they will be hosting a Golf Cart Parade, Poker Run and Cruise in on Saturday the 19th of July. Registration is at the Splash Pad Pavilion from 3:00 to 3:30pm; the parade/Poker Run starts at 3:30pm.
