\*Land donated by Gardner Mudge to the Chicago, Indianapolis and Louisville railway.

\*Mudge and brother-in-law operated a general store.

\*1854 a post office was added and Mudge served as postmaster

\*Chalmers was platted in 1873.

\*Originally was 103 lots on 6 streets.

\*Had 600 residents

\*Consisted of Two grain elevators, a factory, fifteen stores, two banks, two livery barns, three blacksmiths shops, a lumber yard, two hotels and two garages.
